

SPIRITUAL GIFTS QUESTIONNAIRE

How to Complete the Questionnaire

Each statement in the following questionnaire has five possible responses related to how much the statement is true of you: Very Little, Little, Some, Much, Very Much. These represent percentages on a scale of 1-100%, as follows:

1 - Very Little = 0-20%

2 - Little = 20-40%

3 - Some = 40-60%

4 - Much = 60-80%

5 - Very Much = 80 - 100%

Read each statement. Decide to what extent the statement is true of you. Circle the appropriate number. Your first impressions are usually correct.

Don't worry if most of your answers are placed toward the right or toward the left. But try to avoid putting too many marks in the middle, or "Some" column.

Scoring the Questionnaire

Complete this key chart on your own after completing the preceding questionnaire. Begin by reading the following instructions carefully.

1. Place the number 1,2,3,4, or 5, which you have assigned to each of the 126 statements in the questionnaire, next to the corresponding number on the next page.
2. Add each row of three numbers in the Working-Gift Chart and the Waiting-Gift Chart across to the right, and write the sum in the Total box on the right side of each chart.
3. Circle the four highest scores in the Working-Gift Chart Total column and write the names of these gifts in the box at the bottom titled My Working Gifts. List the highest numbers first. In case of a tie, give the higher rating to the gift that has the highest combined score for both waiting and working gifts.
4. Next look at the Waiting-Gift Chart Total column. Circle the four highest scores in this column that were not identified as working gifts. Write these gifts in the box entitled My Waiting Gifts, again listing the highest numbers first. Break any ties as you did in number 3 above.

Remember that although the remaining gifts may not be your spiritual gifts, you still have a responsibility in each of these areas.
